Description:

Come to Project DEEP's Bonaire Trip! Enjoy six (6) days of warm blue water diving. Unlimited diving, what more could you ask for?!

1. Required Documents

MUST have one of the following:

- Have been certified by a recognized agency (NAUI, PADI, YMCA, etc.).
- Currently enrolled in a certification course and recommended by their instructor (\$100 Inst. fee)

(Your instructor reserves final authority on certification. A safe ATTITUDE is of primary importance in determining your certification)

- Valid Passport and Valid Driver's License

2. Trip Dates

- June 14th – June 21st, 2024, Arrival time being from 2pm – 3:30pm on the 14th, Checkout by 10am on the 21st.

3. Lodging

- Captain Don's Habitat – 103 Kaya Gob. N. Debrot, Kralendijk, Caribbean, Netherlands.
- Seven (7) night stay, AIR CONDITIONED, Full kitchen – 2 Bedroom (1 Queen/King and 2 twins), 2 Bath.

4. Diving (Subject to weather)

- Unlimited 24/7 shore diving
- 6 days - 1 tank boat dives
- 4 FREE 1 tank afternoon dives
- Free Nitrox on all dives

5. Equipment

- Breakfast is included at Captain Don's Habitat.
- Lunches and Dinner are on your own. Lots of local options.

7. Travel

- Airfare to Bonaire is included. Flight direct from Newark, NJ to Bonaire.
- Transportation in Bonaire is included. One truck per bungalow. [**Must be 25 or older to drive**]

Length of Stay: 8 Days, 7 Nights

Accommodations: 2 bedroom, 2 bathroom bungalows. It offers a full kitchen and air conditioned rooms throughout. One bedroom is fitted with a king or queen-sized bed, while the other has two (2) twin beds. There will be four guests to a bungalow. Additionally, each bungalow will come with a vehicle. You must be 25 or older, with a valid driver's license to operate.

DIVING INFORMATION:

There is no diving on travel days: 6/14 and 6/21

Boat diving offers six (6) 1-tank morning dives. They are offering four (4) 1-tank afternoon dives at no additional cost.

Shore diving is unlimited and 24/7. You can pack your gear in the provided trucks and travel anywhere on the island to shore dive.

Nitrox is offered for all diving on the island, boat and shore. If you are not certified in Nitrox, Project DEEP will offer a special Nitrox class for this trip. It will have an eLearning and online exam requirement, followed by a 1-hour, in-person, practical application of Nitrox tank analyzing, along with a discussion and questions component.

Project DEEP is a non-profit organization that provides safe diving through education. We take pride in knowing our trips have minimal impact on the marine environment and we are a nuisance to no one. In the event of an incident or accident, diving related or other, Project DEEP reserves the right to discontinue diving services originally offered with the trip to any party involved.
