Description:

This course is designed for someone with no SCUBA experience. It consists of pool and classroom time, meeting once a week for 10 weeks from 7pm - 10pm. Half of the time is spent in the pool learning to use SCUBA equipment, the other half is spent in the classroom. An optional weekend of diving in the ocean, leading to NAUI Scuba Diver Certification, will be scheduled near the end of the 10 weeks.

Project DEEP is a non-profit agency that offers SCUBA courses at Umass. The certifying agency for this course NAUI (National Association of Underwater Instructors).

1. Prerequisite:

Able to swim and enjoy being in the water.

2. Meeting Schedule:

- a. SCUBA classes start the week of 9/3/2024. Sections are held Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. You must attend the night you are enrolled in. Class starts promptly at 7 PM in the Curry Hicks Pool, students must be fully prepared to start by this time. The course number is NRC 120 to enroll and receive credit.
- b. Holidays and UMass schedule changes are not typically observed. Concerns should be addressed with your instructor well in advance of these days.
- c. Bring a bathing suit and a towel every night, INCLUDING the first night.

3. General Conditions:

- a. Course fees are broken down as follows:
 - i. Pool/Classroom instruction and Academic Kit paid to Project DEEP by the 2nd class meeting \$300.00
 - ii. Optional Open Water Instruction and certification card paid to Project DEEP by the 5th class meeting \$150.00.

(Students taking a referral need to have their open water instructor issue them a Certification Card.)

[Project DEEP does not participate in the "Universal Referral Program"]

- iii. Make checks or money orders payable to Project DEEP. (Bounced check fee \$25.00)
- b. Students must supply their own mask, fins, snorkel, wet suit boots (optional for pool). These items will be **needed** for the **SECOND CLASS MEETING**. Students who do not already own this equipment can order it at the first class, and have it delivered just before the second-class meeting, for a cost of \$160 and up.
- c. For the optional open water certification Project DEEP provides the weight belt, regulator, BCD and 2 tanks.
 - i. Cold-water wetsuit, hood and gloves are the student's responsibility.
- d. Course fees do not cover expenses/incidentals to go on the open water weekend (transportation, housing, food, air fills, etc.).
- e. In the unlikely event that you should need to disenroll from the course, monies are refundable on a prorated basis. \$200.00 of both the classroom fee and open water fee is non-refundable as this covers registration. In addition, scheduling changes for open water weekends with less than two weeks' notice will incur full forfeiture.
- f. Because of rigid NAUI and Project DEEP standards, attendance is required at all classes. No absences are permitted. A minimum of 10 class meetings is required. A minimum score of 85% on the final is required for certification. Your instructor reserves final authority on certification. A safe ATTITUDE is of primary importance in determining your certification.
